Program Itinerary

Day One – March 18

After you and your family arrive in Washington, D.C., you will need to meet at the designated location. Here you will join the other tour participants and your ACTS Program Leader aboard the luxury motor coach.

A photo stop visit to the White House and a visit to the White House Visitor Center will be the first stops in our nation's capital city. We then visit Ford's Theater and the Peterson House across the street where Abraham Lincoln died.

The evening starts off with a Welcome Dinner, and a visit to the Jefferson Memorial.

You then will be checked into your included accommodations.

Day Two – March 19

We spend this morning visiting Capitol Hill. We start with a photo stop in front of the United States Supreme Court, then visit the Library of Congress and the Visitor's Center of the U.S. Capitol with time to visit the public galleries and exhibits.

After lunch, we will visit the National Archives to see the Declaration of Independence, the Constitution, and the Bill of Rights.

Later this afternoon, we visit the World War II Memorial and plan to ride to the top of the Washington Monument for some amazing views of the city.

Following dinner, we will visit the Lincoln Memorial which is flanked by the Vietnam and Korean War Veteran's Memorials before returning to our hotel.

Day Three – March 20

This morning, we visit the Mount Vernon Estate, home of George and Martha Washington. You will be able to tour not only the mansion, but also the grounds - seeing the tomb of the Washington's, and also the museum and education center.

This afternoon our theme is sacrifice as we visit Arlington National Cemetery. We will view the Changing of the Guard Ceremony at the Tomb of the Unknowns. We then visit the nearby Iwo Jima (Marine Corps) Memorial.

This evening, after dinner, we will visit the Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial.
